Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

**Monday, May 1, 2017, Dominion East Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement
Project – 2948**

Rocky River Drive & Puritas (City of Cleveland Ward 17)

Expect additional traffic notices as work progresses

CLEVELAND – Pipeline infrastructure improvements will begin on Monday, May 1, 2017 and includes work on the following streets:

- Rocky River Dr. – From Puritas north to Fairway & Laverne Intersections
- Rocky River Dr. – From Sedalia north to Larchwood

Improvement to infrastructure begins with the replacement of old steel mainlines. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times with traffic control personnel in the work zone(s) directing traffic. One-lane traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times on Rocky River Drive with traffic control present in the work zone directing traffic. In addition, a Law Enforcement Officer (L.E.O.) will be present at all signalized intersections. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction as well. The work will take place during daytime hours from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

NOTE: This work is taking place in advance of Water Pollution Control's sewer upgrade project on Rocky River. Final restorations of the Dominion project work will be coordinated with the WPC project restorations.

This project is scheduled for completion by September 2017.
