Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

Monday, June 25, 2018

**Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project – PIR 3115
Caine Avenue
(City of Cleveland Ward 1)**

CLEVELAND – On Monday, June 25, 2018 Dominion Energy Ohio's gas pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following street:

- Caine Avenue – From East 133rd Street to East 142nd Street

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the sidewalk area on the north side of the street. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times through the work zone with traffic control personnel directing traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction and the work will take place Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in August 2018.
