## **Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update**

**Tuesday, October 8, 2019**

**Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project - PIR 3212  
South Bound East 79<sup>th</sup> Street at Woodland Avenue Road Closure  
(City of Cleveland - Wards 5 & 6)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Tuesday, October 8, 2019 a four-day road closure for south bound traffic on East 79<sup>th</sup> Street from Woodland Avenue to Grand Avenue will be in place.

The road closure is required in order to make road repairs to the concrete pavement under the Pennsylvania Lines railroad bridge just south of Woodland Avenue.

A detour plan with signage will be in place for:

- **Northbound traffic** on East 79<sup>th</sup> Street between Grand Avenue and Woodland Avenue will be unaffected.
- **Southbound traffic** along East 79<sup>th</sup> Street will be routed west onto Woodland Avenue to East 75<sup>th</sup> Street, then south on East 75<sup>th</sup> Street to Grand Avenue. At Grand Avenue traffic will head east to East 79<sup>th</sup> Street.
- **Eastbound traffic** along Woodland Avenue will be routed to East 75<sup>th</sup> Street, then south on East 74<sup>th</sup> Street to Grand Avenue. At Grand Avenue traffic will head east to East 79<sup>th</sup> Street.
- **Westbound traffic** along Woodland Avenue will be routed west to East 75<sup>th</sup> Street, then south on East 75<sup>th</sup> Street to Grand Avenue. At Grand Avenue traffic will head east to East 79<sup>th</sup> Street.

It is anticipated that the south bound closure on East 79<sup>th</sup> Street will reopen to traffic on Saturday, October 12, 2019.
