National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week

October 23, 2016 - October 29, 2016

CLEVELAND – On Monday, October 24, 2016, the City of Cleveland will hold a kick-off event for National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week 2016: “Lead-Free Kids for a Healthy Future.” The program will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the City Hall Rotunda, 601 Lakeside Avenue, 1st Floor. Immediately following the program there will be an information fair that will end at 1:00 p.m.

In addition to the kick-off event, the Cleveland Department of Public Health in collaboration with community partners will, throughout the week, conduct lead testing of children less than six years of age and provide information on keeping homes and families lead-safe.
